

Marion Brooks-Wallace (1917-2007)



Marion Brooks-Wallace passed away peacefully on September 3, 2007 at the age of 89.

Marion had been a Professor in the Department of Entomology at the University of Minnesota, where she had obtained her bachelor's, masters and PhD degrees. After retiring in 1986, Marion established a research fellowship in her name to support basic insect science research in the

Department. This fellowship is awarded annually to the best PhD applicant working on insect physiology.

According to Betty Davidson, Marion had been an active member of Society for Invertebrate Pathology during its early days and was Secretary of the Society from 1972 to 1974.
